Topic: UIDC student contest as a part of the work for the Airport connector

The Urban International Design Contest (UIDC) is a student design competition involving cities, universities, and local sponsors. The purpose of UIDC is to empower students to educate, inspire and motivate important stakeholders to design and visualize how new modes of sustainable public transit can be utilized in the urban environment.

We propose the following:

Students from all over the world are already working on design and solutions very similar for what this RFI is about. They use modern digital transit technology in conjunction with traditional studies and reports.

We suggest that the City of San Jose uses the UIDC project and team up with several groups of students to create a communication between stakeholders and evaluate different options – one team makes a demo for one solution, another for a second option etcetera. Please see examples what has been done in the past in cities such as Washington DC, Jacksonville, Stockholm, Perth (Australia), Ithaca NY, Las Vegas and many other.
